ABOUT US: Women of Hope is a 501 (c) 3, faith-based organization devoted to addressing the alarming problem of homelessness and instability among women and children in Northeast Ohio. The current focus population includes homeless women veterans and women in reentry who are attempting to sustain a healthy lifestyle and self-sufficiency. All our properties are sober houses.

Through its Firm Family Foundations Program, Women of Hope equips and empowers women and their families to experience wraparound care through an array of offerings and supports. Participants are equipped to live successfully in recovery, access affordable housing, and develop plans for overall wellness.

CURRENT HOMES Women of Hope has secured three homes through partnership with the Cuyahoga Land Bank. Two are 4-bedroom homes, which offers shared living for women in transition from incarceration and/or recovering from substance use. Also, a 3-bedroom home designated for a family homeless or at risk of homelessness. One of our goals is to provide affordable housing for families. All program participants have access to the Firm Foundations Program.
